#### Meeting started at 1915hrs

#### 175/24 Public Participation.

There was one member of public in attendance who wished to raise concerns about Rough Close Common with regards to the high number of self-setting trees some of which are now mature as the area should be a heath land. The member of public also raised the question to if the cattle were causing this issue and could they be doing more harm than good.

Cllr A Sandiford informed the member of public that he had met with Cllr Waller recently at the Common and he agreed that there should not be any trees and that funding was a big problem but Staffordshire wildlife was coming on board.

The member of public informed the meeting that there would be a lot of residents and businesses happy to volunteer to remove the trees providing they could keep the wood.

Cllr A Sandiford agreed to discuss this with SBC and meet with the Clerk to form a volunteers working group if SBC agreed.

The member of public left the meeting.

The Police attended and had nothing formal to report. The Police informed the meeting that they had been working with the Clerk to hopefully have SPACE sessions running in the Parish over Summer, also to arranged dates for Summer Drop-in Clinics to go in the next Parish Newsletter.

Cllr Sandiford informed the meeting that he had been working on:

- Antisocial Behaviour Team in SBC to help with problems in the Parish.
- Homes Plus should decide by the end of the month with regards to all the garages
- Dealing with complaints about speeding through the Parish.
- Complaints about different sorts of care homes applications in the Parish.

## b) County Councillor

Cllr Parry informed the meeting that he had been working on:

- Meir Heath Crossroads which work is due to commence 12<sup>th</sup> February including improved signage at the top of Windmill Hill for HGVs.
- Speed Limit change from St Mathews Primary School to the Swynnerton Arms.
- Adamwaite Drive due to be surface repaired and then surface dressed.

Cllr Parry informed the meeting that the County Council knows that the roads are in a state, but this is because 2023 was the third wettest year on record. The County Council is investing in pothole pro machines but they would not be useful in rural Fulford because the road is required to be flat and straight.

The County Councils budget was agreed today, and most is the spend is on people, now have a five year balanced budget with healthy reserves. This year's investment will be in libraries and Chase water.
